



Objective: Installing an Absorbent pad under the infusion pump to make cleanup of ink spills easier.



STEP	DISCUSSION	ACTION – DO THIS
1	Remove work surface	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> 🌈 Clear any loose items from the top of the work surface. 🌈 Remove the tester cover by pulling forward and set it aside. 🌈 Raise the vacuum chamber door by pulling forward and up on the handle until it locks into the open (top) position. 🌈 Open the left upper drawer (labeled REFILL ADAPTERS) to gain access to the underside of the work surface and remove the thumb screw fastener. 🌈 Open the right upper drawer (labeled TEST ADAPTERS) to gain access to the underside of the work surface and remove the thumb screw fasteners 🌈 Grasp the sides of the work surface and pull towards you to slide it off the machine.
2	Remove lower back cover	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> 🌈 Using a 3/16" Allen tool, remove the two fasteners securing the lower back cover 🌈 Grasp the handle on cover and pull top of cover away from ink center 🌈 Lift up on cover to release the 2 interlocking tabs and set cover aside

3	<p>Clean under the infusion pump and vacuum pump area</p>  <p>Area should be this clean</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> 🧼 Use paper towels to wipe up any ink residue 🧼 Use the cleaning wipes to remove dried up ink 🧼 Dry with paper towel
4	<p>Place pad under infusion pump and vacuum pump area</p>  <p>Align front of pad with lip</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> 🧼 Position Pad under the infusion pump. 🧼 Make sure it does not go under the supplies drawer as it may cause issue opening or closing that drawer
5	<p>Complete Total Service Call</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> 🧼 Please complete the TSC and address any other machine issues
7	<p>Reinstall covers and work surface</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> 🧼 Install covers in reverse order of steps 1 and 2
