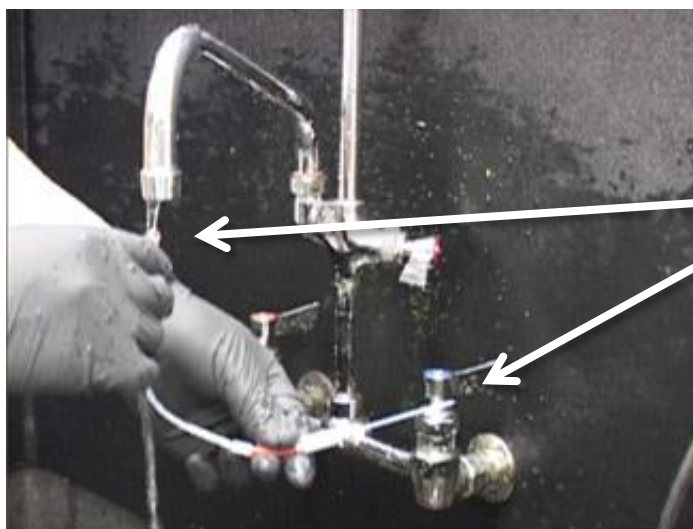
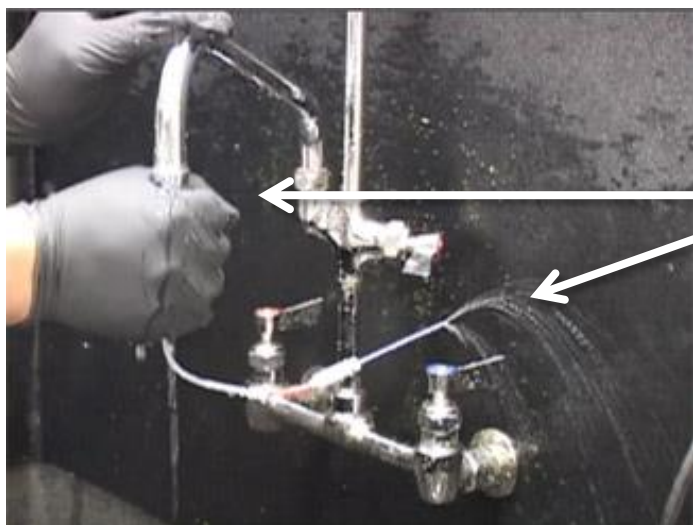


Injectors and lines may not be clogged

Don't be fooled. Image 1 shows what some people are doing when they suspect that injectors are clogged. There will need to be at least a little pressure on the line in order to squirt water from the two holes in the needle tip. Image 2 shows what it should look like. Use gloves in the sink to create a good seal



Notice that there is no pressure for water to come out of the tip



This picture clearly shows that the injectors are not clogged. To achieve this you may need to wear gloves to create a seal. The water faucet should be on a little above a trickle.
